

INTRO PSYCH RESEARCH PROJECTS

General Instructions: Each of the activities listed below should result in a 2-3 page paper of the experience or activity (specific content will be described in the handouts for each paper). Each of the assigned papers/projects will have their own start/end date. With the exception of the first project – all will have a 2-week window of time to complete the work and **NO LATE PAPERS WILL BE ACCEPTED**. All work must be submitted as pdf files and the timestamps will be used as the official turn-in time. There will be a total of 5 activities and all students must do 4.

Please note that for each paper – the page limits are for **CONTENT**. Students have in the past attempted to use creative ways to turn very short papers into something meeting the basic requirements. Please be warned that this is a very bad idea. 2-3 pages of content means 2-3 pages of content.

Paper requirements: We'll use the same typing requirements used in all Psych classes: 1-inch margins around all sides, 23-25 lines per page, font = times 12 point. As a reminder - 2 pages means 2 pages of content.
